4. Legislative Session

The Board to review 2023 legislative bills related to the practice of psychology in order to form, maintain, or amend its position on the measures.

The Board may enter into Executive Session to consult with the Board's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities in accordance with HRS section 92-5(a)(4)

A. HB1300 - RELATING TO MENTAL HEALTH.

Establishes provisional or associate-level licensure requirements for marriage and family therapists, mental health counselors, and psychologists and authorizes insurance reimbursements in certain circumstances. Requires psychologist license applicants to possess a doctoral degree and complete certain supervised experience requirements before sitting for the licensing examination. Authorizes insurance reimbursements for services provided by a supervised social work intern in certain circumstances. Appropriates funds. Effective 6/30/2050. (SD1)

5. Board Delegations

The Board to review current delegations to the Executive Officer including related to the approval of nationally certified applicants (e.g., hold National Register certification), certain examination and examination waiver applications that does not require the Board's expertise or discretion, incl. temporary permits, and senior psychologist applications. The Board will also assess a new delegation, related to the approval and issuing of a license for applicants conditionally approved by the Board.
