Board members Jonathan Lucas and Janet Primiano represented the Board at the NCARB Regional Summit in Philadelphia, PA from February 28 – March 1, 2025.

- b. Inquiry from Bing Lee regarding Board consideration of administrative rules revision for allowing waiver of the Fundamentals of Engineering ("FE") exam with experience for Professional Engineer ("PE") licensure application via exam

Pursuant to HAR §16-115-27, PE applicants who are not licensed in another jurisdiction, and are therefore applying for licensure "via exam," shall be required to pass both the FE and PE exams. Waiver of the FE exam is currently only available to qualifying individuals applying for PE licensure "via endorsement" (i.e. already licensed in another jurisdiction).

- c. Anonymous email regarding "plan stamping" in Maui County

Pursuant to HAR §16-115-10(4) Misconduct in the practice, "plan stamping" includes, "sealing, stamping, or certifying any document which was not prepared by or supervised by the licensee."

- d. Clarification of acceptable digital signatures for authenticating plans, specifications, maps, reports, surveys, descriptions, and every sheet in a set of design drawings prepared by or under the supervision of a licensed EASLA professional, pursuant to HAR §16-115-9(e)

HAR §16-115-9 Authentication: preparation or supervision of design and observation of construction, subsection (e) reads, "All signatures required under this section shall be an original or a digital signature is also acceptable. The use of rubber signature stamps or other facsimile signatures is prohibited."
