When recognized by the Chairperson, please unmute your microphone before speaking and mute your microphone after you finish speaking.

PHONE ACCESS:

If you cannot get internet access, you may get audio-only access by calling the phone number listed at the top on the agenda.

Upon dialing the number, you will be prompted to enter the Meeting ID which is also listed at the top of the agenda. 6. Executive Officer's Report:

a. 2024 Legislation

- 1) HB 1777, HD 1 – Relating to Dental Hygienists

Description: Authorizes dental hygienists who are under the general supervision of a licensed dentist to perform preventive dental sealant screenings and apply dental sealants on certain individuals in a school-based oral health program. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)

- 2) SB 2476, HD 2, CD 1 – Relating to Dental Hygienists

Description: Authorizes licensed dental hygienists to perform preventive dental sealant screenings and apply dental sealants on individuals, under certain conditions, in a school-based oral health program. (CD1)

- 3) HB 2744, HD 2, SD 1 – Relating to Oral Health

Description: Establishes an Oral Health Task Force to review the status of oral health in the State and make recommendations to improve the State's oral health infrastructure. Requires reports to the Legislature. Declares that the general fund expenditure ceiling is exceeded. Appropriates funds. (SD1)

b. Web Notice Posted Regarding the use of Lead Aprons

The Board responded to the February 1, 2024 announcement by the American Dental Association (“ADA”) reminding all Hawaii licensees that the ADA guidance does not change the existing requirements of Hawaii Revised Statutes (“HRS”) §448-1.5 and Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) §16-79-7 requiring the use of lead aprons during x-rays/radiographic procedures.
