 1. S.B. 60, Relating to Health
Report Title: Controlled Substances; Prescriptions; Out-Of-State Prescribers
Description: Authorizes state-licensed and credentialed physicians, advanced practice registered nurses, and physician assistants, who are not physically in the State, to issue prescriptions for certain controlled substances under a limited circumstance. Authorizes pharmacies to dispense the prescriptions.
 2. S.B. 165/H.B. 1221, Relating to Pharmacists
Report Title: Insurance Coverage; Pharmacists; Reimbursement
Description: Mandates reimbursement for services provided by participating registered pharmacists practicing within their scope of practice by private and public health plans in the State beginning January 1, 2024.
 3. S.B. 608/H.B. 218, Relating To Prescription Drugs
Report Title: Deaf and Blind Task Force; Prescription Drug Label Information; Accessibility; Pharmacies; Board of Pharmacy; Administrative Rules
Description: Requires pharmacies to provide accessible prescription drug label information to individuals who have difficulty seeing or reading prescription drug container labels and inform the public that prescription drug label information is available in alternate accessible formats for individuals who have difficulty seeing or reading prescription drug container labels. Requires the Board of Pharmacy to adopt certain rules by December 31, 2023.
 4. S.B. 602/H.B. 659, Relating to Health
Report Title: Diagnostic Testing; CLIA-Waived Tests; Pharmacists; Education Requirements
Description: Establishes permitting and education requirements for pharmacists performing certain diagnostic tests or tests waived pursuant to the Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments of 1988 (CLIA). Expands the definition of “practice of pharmacy” to include the performance of certain diagnostic or CLIA-waived tests.
 5. S.B. 604, Relating to Health

Report Title: Abortion; Reproductive Health Care Services; Information; Privacy; Protection

Description: Prohibits state and county employees and officers from providing reproductive health care services patient information or expending state resources in furtherance of another state's investigation or proceeding that seeks to impose civil, criminal, or professional liability upon a person or entity related to reproductive health care services. Prohibits any person from being compelled to provide reproductive health care services patient information. Prohibits any persons from being disqualified from licensure or subject to discipline by a Hawai'i board of professional licensure for providing reproductive health care services.

6. S.B. 693, Relating to Pharmacists

Report Title: Auditor; Impact Study; Insurance Coverage; Pharmacists; Reimbursement; Report; Appropriation

Description: Requires the auditor to conduct an assessment on the social and financial impacts of mandating health insurance coverage for care provided by a participating registered pharmacist practicing within the scope of the pharmacist's license. Requires a report to the legislature before the 2024 regular session. Appropriates funds.

7. S.B. 1017, Relating to Health

Report Title: Advance Health-Care Directive; Voluntary Non-Opioid Option

Description: Adds a voluntary non-opioid option to the sample advance health-care directive form. Establishes that a prescription presented or electronically transmitted to a pharmacy shall be presumed valid and grants pharmacists immunity from civil, criminal, and professional liability for dispensing an opioid in contravention of a patient's non-opioid directive.

8. H.B. 218 (HD2 SD1), Relating to Prescription Drugs

Report Title: Deaf and Blind Task Force; Prescription Drug Label Information; Accessibility; Pharmacies; Board of Pharmacy; Administrative Rules

Description: Requires certain pharmacies to provide accessible prescription drug label information to individuals who have difficulty seeing or reading prescription drug container labels and inform the public that prescription drug label information is available in alternate accessible formats for individuals who have difficulty seeing or reading prescription drug container labels. Requires the board of pharmacy to adopt certain rules by 12/31/2024.

9. S.B. 473 (SD1 HD1), Relating to the Practice of Pharmacy

Report Title: Practice of Pharmacy; Dialysate Drugs or Devices; Manufacturers; Wholesalers; Third-Party Logistics Providers; Exemption

Description: Exempts manufacturers, wholesale distributors, and third-party logistics providers of home dialysate drugs or devices from the license, registration, and permit requirements for pharmacies, under certain conditions.
