 - 1) SB 60 Relating to Health

Report Title: Controlled Substances; Prescriptions; Out-Of-State Prescribers
Description: Mandates reimbursement for services provided by participating registered pharmacists practicing within their scope of practice by private and public health plans in the State beginning January 1, 2024.
 - 2) SB 165/HB 1221 Relating to Pharmacists

Report Title: Insurance Coverage; Pharmacists; Reimbursement
Description: Authorizes state-licensed and credentialed physicians, advanced practice registered nurses, and physician assistants, who are not physically in the State, to issue prescriptions for certain controlled substances under a limited circumstance. Authorizes pharmacies to dispense the prescriptions.
 - 3) SB 608/HB 218 Relating To Prescription Drugs

Report Title: Deaf and Blind Task Force; Prescription Drug Label Information; Accessibility; Pharmacies; Board of Pharmacy; Administrative Rules
Description: Requires pharmacies to provide accessible prescription drug label information to individuals who have difficulty seeing or reading prescription drug container labels and inform the public that prescription drug label information is available in alternate accessible formats for individuals who have difficulty seeing or reading prescription drug container labels. Requires the Board of Pharmacy to adopt certain rules by December 31, 2023.
 - 4) SB 604 Relating to Health

Report Title: Abortion; Reproductive Health Care Services; Information; Privacy; Protection

- Description:** Prohibits state and county employees and officers from providing reproductive health care services patient information or expending state resources in furtherance of another state's investigation or proceeding that seeks to impose civil, criminal, or professional liability upon a person or entity related to reproductive health care services. Prohibits any person from being compelled to provide reproductive health care services patient information. Prohibits any persons from being disqualified from licensure or subject to discipline by a Hawai'i board of professional licensure for providing reproductive health care services.
- 5) SB 693 Relating to Pharmacists
Report Title: Insurance Coverage; Pharmacists; Reimbursement
Description: Mandates reimbursement for services provided by participating registered pharmacists practicing within their scope of practice by private and public health plans in the State beginning January 1, 2024.
- 6) SB 1017 Relating to Health
Report Title: Advance Health-Care Directive; Voluntary Non-Opioid Option
Description: Adds a voluntary non-opioid option to the sample advance health-care directive form. Establishes that a prescription presented or electronically transmitted to a pharmacy shall be presumed valid and grants pharmacists' immunity from civil, criminal, and professional liability for dispensing an opioid in contravention of a patient's non-opioid directive.
- 7) SB 2199/ HB 1825 Relating To Out-Of-State Prescriptions
Report Title: Pharmacists; Out-of-State Prescriptions; Initial Fill
Description: Authorizes out-of-state pharmacists to transfer prescription information for the initial fill of a prescription.
- 8) HB 1836 Relating to Health
Report Title: Pharmacists; Refills; Dangerous Drugs; Dangerous Devices; State of Emergency
Description: Allows pharmacists, during declared states of emergency, to refill prescriptions of up to thirty-day supplies of dangerous drugs and dangerous devices if the prescriber is unavailable or cannot be contacted to authorize the refill and if, in the pharmacist's professional judgment, failure to refill the prescription might interrupt the patient's ongoing care and have a significant adverse effect on the patient's well-being.
- 9) HB 2113 Relating to Pharmacy
Report Title: Pharmacy; Pharmacists; Daniel K. Inouye College of Pharmacy Special Fund; Pharmacist Workforce Assessment Fees; Appropriation
Description: Establishes the Daniel K. Inouye College of Pharmacy Special Fund to support pharmacist workforce assessment and planning efforts. Establishes the pharmacist workforce assessment fee. Appropriates funds.
- 10) HB 2147/SB 2568 Relating to Health
Report Title: Vaccinations; Children; Pharmacists; Pharmacies
Description: Authorizes pharmacists to order and administer immunizations and vaccinations to children three years of age and older under state law.
- 11) SB 2899 Relating to Pharmacists
Report Title: Auditor; Impact Study; Insurance Coverage; Pharmacists; Reimbursement; Report; Expenditure Ceiling; Appropriation
Description: Requires the auditor to conduct an assessment on the social and financial impacts of mandating health insurance coverage for care provided by a participating registered pharmacist practicing within the scope of the pharmacist's license. Requires a report to the legislature before the 2025 regular session. Declares that the general fund expenditure is exceeded. Makes an appropriation.
- 12) HB 2553 Relating to Pharmacists
Report Title: Pharmacists; Pharmacy Interns; Pharmacy Technicians; Minors; Vaccinations
Description: Authorizes pharmacists, pharmacy interns, and pharmacy technicians under the direct supervision of a pharmacist to administer vaccinations to persons between the ages of

three and seventeen, if certain requirements are met. Authorizes licensed pharmacists to order vaccines for administration to persons between the ages of three and seventeen.

13) HB 2554 Relating to Pharmacies

Report Title: Pharmacists; Practice of Pharmacy; Pharmacy Employees; Staffing Requirements

Description: Requires pharmacies, other than on-site pharmacies in institutional facilities, to make a pharmacy intern, pharmacy technician, pharmacy employee, or an employee of the retail establishment the pharmacy is located in available to assist a registered pharmacist at all times the pharmacy is open to the public.

14) HB 1979 Relating to Prescription Drugs

Report Title: Canadian Prescription Drug Importation Program; DOH; Appropriation; Expenditure Ceiling

Description: Establishes the Canadian Prescription Drug Importation Program to be implemented and administered by the Department of Health. Requires the Department of Health to obtain federal approval, make reports, and adopt rules. Appropriates funds.
