When the Chairperson asks for public testimony, you may click the Raise Hand button found on your Zoom screen to indicate that you wish to testify about that agenda item. The Chairperson will individually enable each testifier to unmute their microphone. When recognized by the Chairperson, please unmute your microphone

before speaking and mute your microphone after you finish speaking.

PHONE ACCESS:

If you cannot get internet access, you may get audio-only access by calling the phone number listed at the top on the agenda. Upon dialing the number, you will be prompted to enter the Meeting ID which is also listed at the top of the agenda. After entering the Meeting ID, you will be asked to either enter your panelist number or wait to be admitted into the meeting. You will not have a panelist number. So, please wait until you are admitted into the meeting.

When the Chairperson asks for public testimony, you may indicate you want to testify by entering “*” and then “9” on your phone’s keypad. After entering “*” and then “9”, a voice prompt will let you know that the host of the meeting has been notified. When recognized by the Chairperson, you may unmute yourself by pressing “*” and then “6” on your phone. A voice prompt will let you know that you are unmuted. Once you are finished speaking, please enter “*” and then “6” again to mute yourself.

4. Review of Advisory Committee Member Candidates

The Board to review candidates for the Regulated Industries Complaints Office's ("RICO") Speech Pathology & Audiology Advisory Committee to become effective January 1, 2024.

The Board may enter into Executive Session to consult with the Board's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities in accordance with HRS section 92-5(a)(4).

5. Licensure Requirements, Practice Standards, and Legislation and Rules Change

The Board to review its statutes and Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") chapter 16-100 for areas that may need amendment or rules change to maintain functionality. In light of this, the Board will begin: (1) preparing for the 2024 State legislative session developing possible legislation or rules language it supports; (2) the Board may also review its administrative rules chapter and prepare necessary or possible changes; and (3) the Board may also reassess its current permitted interaction group created to research and develop telehealth, statute or rule language, which may involve voting to update or dissolve the group, and creating a legislative committee for the legislative session.

The Board may enter into Executive Session to consult with the Board's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities in accordance with HRS section 92-5(a)(4).

To organize the discussion, the Board will review the following subjects:

A. SLP-IC: Interstate Compact

The Board to discuss the speech-language pathologist interstate compact ("SLP-IC") introduced last session as S.B. 317-Relating to the Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology Interstate Compact. The bill permits those registered with the compact to practice in member states without obtaining licensure.

B. Telehealth/Remote Practice

The Board to discuss the subject of remote practice and training by the use of telehealth modalities used as they relate to the practice of Speech Pathology and Audiology.

C. Board of Speech Pathology & Audiology

Board to discuss section 468E-6, which establishes the board and its makeup in relation to board meeting and administrative matters being hindered by limits on such things as quorum, for example: (1) public member must be in attendance.

D. Licensure (full- and provisional-type), Requirements, and ASHA Certification

The Board to review the requirements for licensure via meeting the requirements of ASHA certification, provisional licensure, and licensure by examination. The Board to see if the requirements, set forth in chapter 468E, HRS, and 16-100, HAR, for examination are current with national standards, or need to be updated by legislation or rules change.

E. Renewals, Continuing Education, and ASHA Certification

The Board to review possible legislative or rules change to address whether a Speech Pathologist or Audiologist licensed by holding national certification such as ASHA's certificate of clinical competence ("CCC") or the American Board of Audiology's certification must maintain their said certification after obtaining licensure.

F. Speech Language Pathologist Assistants ("SLPA")

The Board to continue discussing the use of SLPAs in the practice of speech pathology in Hawaii. The Board may discuss current training options in Hawaii, utilization of SLPAs in practice, and possible regulation of SLPAs.
