4. Provisional Licensure Applications

The Board to review possible updates to the application process for those who will not have the required qualifying supervisor before the beginning of their clinical fellowship year or employment.

5. Remote Practice

The Board to discuss matters related to the practice of speech pathology and audiology as it relates to remote practice, including but not limited to: remote training or supervision, remote practice, telehealth modalities used currently by clinics and practices, the ASLP-IC and its introduction into the legislature via SB317, question of rural-dependence on telehealth, and other subjects that would allow the Board to assess drafting possible legislation (including an administrative bill), administrative rules or informal opinions based on its authorities, which the Board may do at this meeting. The Board may also reassess its current permitted interaction group created to research and develop telehealth statute or rule language; which may involve voting to update or dissolve the group.
